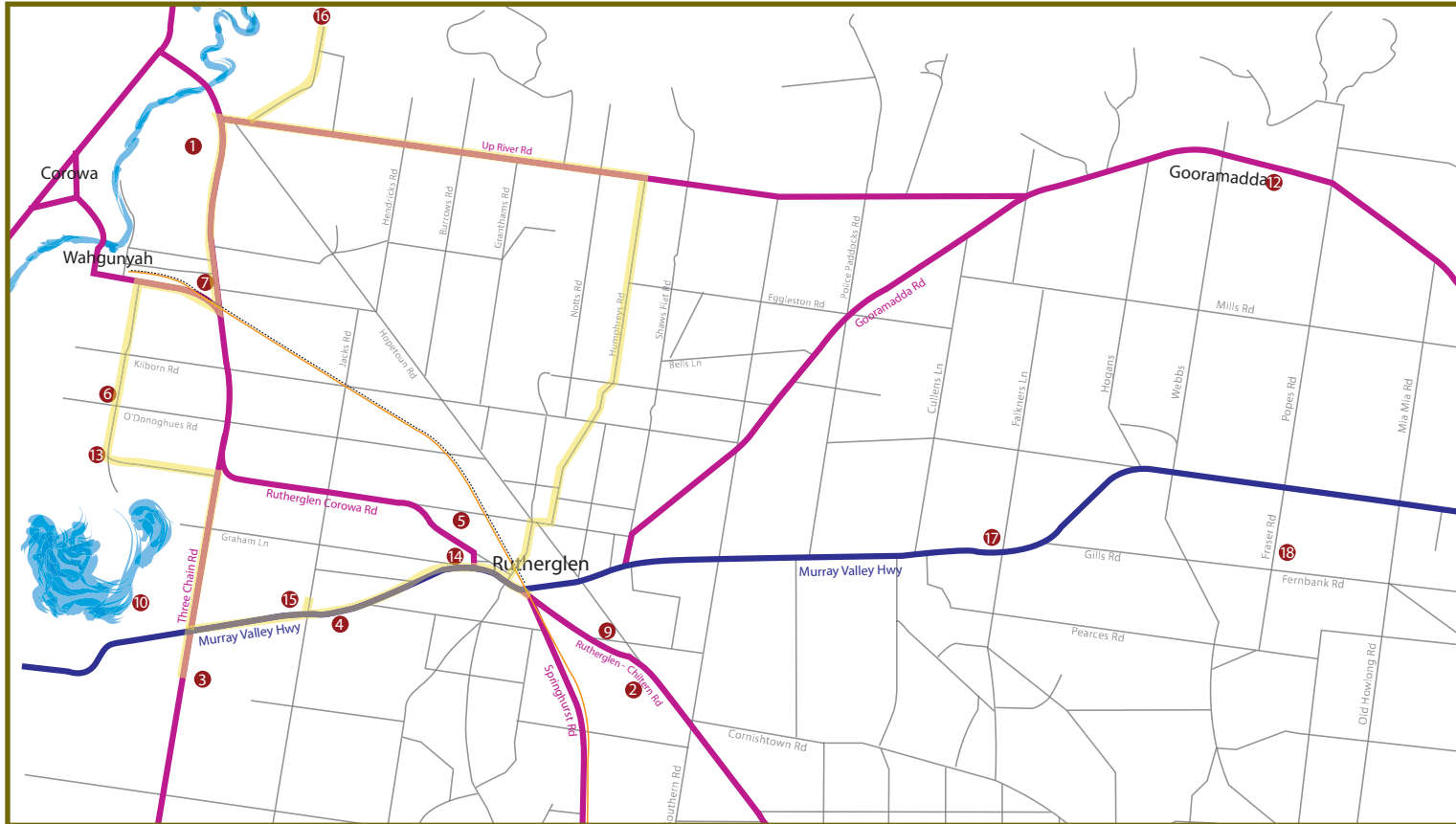









RUTHERGLEN CYCLE ROUTES

RUTHERGLEN WINERIES WEST (Approx 38 kms)

8 Wineries including Campbells Wines, Stanton & Killeen Wines, Buller Wines, Buller Wines, Pfeiffer Wines, Cofield Wines, drinkmoor Wines, All Saints Estate and St Leonards Vineyard

LHS = Left Hand Side RHS = Right Hand Side

Approx Kms	Ride Description
0	Commence ride from Rutherglen Wine Experience Car Park. Proceed west along Main St Rutherglen which turns into the Murray Valley Highway (MVH).
3.1	Campbells Winery (LHS) was established in 1870 and winemaker Colin Campbell is the 5 th generation of Campbells to make wine here. Renown for Bobby Burns Shiraz and their luscious Muscats & Tokays.
3.8	Proceed west along the MVH (400m) and turn right to Stanton & Killeen Wines (RHS) established in 1875. Chris Killeen is a 6 th generation winemaker and is famous for his Vintage Ports.
9.9	Proceed west along MVH until you reach 3 Chain Rd and turn left.
6.7	Buller Wines (LHS) was established in 1921 and has the added attraction of a Bird Park. Andrew Buller is a 4 th generation winemaker whose Calliope (pronounced: kel-i-o-pea) Range of Shiraz, Durif, Rare Muscat & Tokay is truly delectable.
	Back track along 3 Chain Rd to the MVH ⇒ Cross diagonally and proceed north along 3 Chain Rd towards Corowa.
9.9	Turn left at Distillery Rd and proceed along Distillery Rd.
11.5	Pfeiffer Wines was established in 1984 when the Pfeiffer family took over the former Seppelt distillery site. Chris and daughter Jen are the winemakers. Sample the 'House' specialities of Gamay and Auslese Tokay before heading down to the bridge over the Sunday Creek to feed the native turtles.
	Proceed north along Distillery Rd.
13.3	Cofield Wines (LHS) was established in 1990 and now has 2 nd generation winemaker Damien at the helm. Renown for their Sparkling Reds and Quartz Vein range.
	Proceed north along Distillery Rd until you reach the T intersection ⇒ Turn right and proceed (Uncle Tobys on LHS) ⇒ Turn left at All Saints Rd.
16	drinkmoor wines (LHS) was established in 2002. It is a young, innovative, fun winery that is focused on the enjoyment of wine and you must try their 'Sticky'.
	Proceed north along All Saints Rd.
18.4	All Saints Estate (LHS) was established in 1864. Admire the 130 year old Elm Tree driveway and the Castle Winery, based on an original castle in Scotland. Sample their unique Sparkling Cabernet and Marsanne.
	Exit along the Plane Tree driveway. Proceed across All Saints Rd along Up River Rd and take the 2 nd left towards St Leonards.
22.1	St Leonards Winery was established in 1860 and is now part of Peter R Brown Family Vineyards, which also operates All Saints Estate. You might come across the winemaker, Dan Crane who is one of the few Poms making wine in Australia. Sample the fresh & fruity Dry Orange Muscat.
	Back track until you reach the T intersection at Up River Rd and turn left and proceed along Up River Rd.
30.6	Humphreys Rd (RHS). Turn right into Humphreys Rd and proceed back towards Rutherglen.
36.2	T intersection at Barkly St. Turn right and proceed towards the roundabout. Turn left at the roundabout and proceed down High St back into Rutherglen. Turn left at the Main St.
38	Return to the Rutherglen Wine Experience car park.
